## Successful Intervention = Duet

- 4-6 sentences read through themselves
- Go back and read every other word with teacher starting
- Child starts every other word
- 4th time read on their own
  - Immediately correcting their errors
  - Several 3rd graders have exited the reading program

## Successful Intervention = Pencil Tap

• Teacher taps a pencil on the table when there is an error and student hears the sound and fixes it

- ii. ADSIS teacher (Josh Westphal)
  - 1. ADSIS is within the spectrum of student services
  - 2. Program is for students that need extra help
  - 3. Academic Students go to a small study hall type of classroom
    - a. Licensed teacher & paraprofessional
    - b. Filling the gaps in reading or math
    - c. Like a journey of holes in a rowboat
    - d. PathBlazer program by Compass Learning
      - i. Test, intuitive
      - ii. Answers are ranked and it diagnoses how long a student spends on the question
      - iii. Set up a flexible learning plan for the student
      - iv. Re-teaching
      - v. Hopeful the data will help to catch up the students to exit out of the program
- iii. Technology coordinator (Aaron Bergstrahl)
  - 1. Jen Wernau spoke about Schoology
    - a. Beta-testing secure testing
    - b. Voice comments can be spoken to the students
    - c. Has done basic formative assessments in Schoology
